

New date: 25 April 2026 / "1st Henkell 0.0% Vinothon – Wiesbaden-Rheingau Savour Marathon" with a refined concept / From Wiesbaden through one of Germany's most picturesque landscapes / Also half marathon and beginner distance of 8 kilometers possible

As part of a press conference at Schloss Johannisberg (Geisenheim), the organizer WEC GmbH, title sponsor Henkell, the city of Wiesbaden, and the district administrator of the Rheingau-Taunus district presented the refined event concept for the "1st Henkell 0.0% Vinothon – Wiesbaden-Rheingau Savour Marathon".

The new running format will celebrate its Germany premiere on April 25, 2026 (see presentation attached). The Vinothon leads from the event arena at Schloss Henkell through one of Germany's most picturesque landscapes. Past renowned wineries, historic sites (including Schloss Vollrads), and impressive monuments. Personal best times are not the focus, but rather the unique combination of sport and savour.
